- **Cue for places:** *The father was crushed. He fell on his knees and put his arms around his precious little girl. He begged her to forgive him for his unnecessary anger.*

### O Holy Night

- **Adult & Youth Choir “on stage”**

### READING: On Santa’s Team

- Ethan @ podium
- **Cue for places:** *That evening, Grandma helped me wrap the coat in Christmas paper and ribbons, and write, “To Bobbie, From Santa Claus” on it ... Grandma said that Santa always insisted on secrecy.*

- **Kids Choir “on stage”**

### Santa Claus Is Coming To Town

- Kids Choir stays on stage, any youth who would like to join “on stage”

## COSTUME REQUIREMENTS

- **Black Binder for all performers** (we would like all singers in the choir to hold their music in a black binder so that everyone looks the same)
- **All black clothes**, preferred: long sleeves
- **Performers will wear a poinsettia pin** (WILL PROVIDE) **or a tie** (green, red, white, silver, gold)

## CALL TIME

- 6:15pm** for adult & youth performers
- 6:30pm** for kids choir
- 6:30pm** doors open for public

## ADMISSION

- An item - coat, non-perishable food item
- A monetary donation to one cause or all - SPCA, Coats For Kids or Adults, Food Bank

## NOTES:

- The youth members who sat with the kids choir, remember you are leading the kids “on stage” and staying with them while they sing, then leading them “off stage” (Riley, Chloe, Claire, Payton, etc)
- Remember to have eye contact with Courtney: she will cue you when to come in and help you with WHEN to enter and exit
